

**ROSEAU CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING
MONDAY – January 24, 2022, at 5:00 P.M.
Roseau City Council Chambers**

The special meeting of the Roseau City Council was held on the above date, time and place. Members present were, Mayor Dan Fabian, Councilmembers: Pat Novacek, Amy Bassingthwaite, and Brady Johnson; CDC Todd Peterson, and City Attorney Michelle Moren. Others present include Mary Hayes, Scott Jacobson and Bruce Stone.

Mayor Dan Fabian called the meeting to order, and the Pledge of Allegiance was said.

There were 2 items on the agenda for the special meeting:

- Approve the use of alcohol in the Community Center – C&C Banquet (1/24/22 at 5 pm)
- Interview Council Member Applicants

The City Council reviewed the application for use of alcohol in the Community Center for the C&C Banquet on 1-24-22 at 5 pm. After discussion, Council member Amy Bassingthwaite motioned, seconded by Brady Johnson to approve the use of alcohol in the Community Center for the C&C Banquet on 1-24-22 at 5 pm. The motion passed by unanimous vote.

The City Council held interviews with two applicants for the open City Council seat. The City Council first interviewed Mary Hayes, followed by Scott Jacobson. The full Council asked various questions of the applicants. Following the interviews, the City Council deliberated on the selection. After considerable discussion Mayor Dan Fabian motioned, seconded by Amy Bassingthwaite to offer the position of Council Member to Mary Hayes. Both candidates were brought back and notified of the Council's decision, and both were thanked for their interest in serving on the Council. Both were encouraged to run for Council in the upcoming November election when all seats will be back up to election. Mary Hayes was notified that she will receive the oath of office at the February 7, 2022 regular City Council meeting.

There being no further business Councilmember Pat Novacek motioned, seconded by Councilmember Brady Johnson to adjourn the meeting. The motion passed by unanimous vote.
