## **HIRING NOTICE**

### **FULL-TIME POLICE OFFICER**

January 6<sup>th</sup> 2025

The Roseau Police Department will be accepting applications for Full-Time Police Officer positions. Applicants should be Minnesota P.O.S.T. Licensed or eligible to be a licensed Peace Officer. A City Employment Application is required to be completed and submitted to be considered for the position, a resume is also encouraged. Our hiring process includes written assessment, oral interview, fitness testing, extensive background investigation, psychological exam, drug test and physical exam.

Starting hourly pay ranges from \$32.70 to \$40.53 depending on experience. Our department will consist of 7 full-time officers, and 1 administrative assistant. Full-time officers receive 8 hours vacation per month starting, and 12 holidays per year. Sick leave accumulates at a rate of 8 hours per month. A comprehensive group health insurance plan, and life insurance plan are included in the benefits package. The city pays \$1,800 a year to a health savings account to help offset the cost of the health insurance deductible. The city pays \$2.00 an hour for night-time differential.

Roseau is a vibrant community of approximately 3,000 residents with an excellent school system and hospital. Roseau is also the home of Polaris Industries, maker of Polaris snowmobiles and ATV's. Roseau is located 22 miles west of Lake of the Woods, one of the top walleye fisheries in Minnesota. Roseau is an excellent place for the outdoor enthusiast interested in hunting, fishing, and all other outdoor recreational activities.

Applications will be accepted until the positions are filled.
