



Roseau Parks & Recreation— City Parks & Trails Guide

Roseau City Park—City Park is the largest of Roseau’s parks encompassing over 40 acres of recreational lands on the South-east side of Roseau along the Roseau River. City Park is located on 11th Avenue SE.



Amenities:

- Boat Launch to Roseau River
- Multipurpose Trails (paved & unpaved)

North Star Park—North Star Park is a newly developed 10 acre park on the Southwest side of Roseau in the Klema neighborhood at the intersection of 8th Avenue SW and 7th Street SW.



Amenities:

- Playground
- Ballfield
- Soccer Field with goals

- Restroom facilities

West Side Park—West Side Park is a 5 acre neighborhood park serving the residents of the West Side Mobile Home Park and is located on 9th Avenue SW.

Riverview Park—River View Park is a new 5 acre park in the center of Roseau on 3rd Avenue NE that serves as the hub of a chain of public lands along the Roseau River around the Roseau City Center.

Mother’s Memory Garden Park—This small park is located at the northwest corner of the Minnesota Highway 11 Bridge across from the Roseau City Center. The park features a central garden filled with flowers and plants handed down for generations.

Downtown Pocket Park— Located on Main Street near TH 11. This small park provides a great opportunity for a lunchtime break.

South Riverview Park—South Riverview Park was formerly known as Lion’s Park, named after the shelter erected at the park by the Roseau Lion’s Club. This park encompasses over 10 acres of land that once houses the Roseau outdoor pool. This park is still under development.

- Multipurpose Recreational Trail (paved)
- Dedicated ATV trail
- Riverbank fishing
- Sledding hill
- Picnic Shelter
- Basketball hoop



Roseau East Diversion Recreational Area — There are a number of new recreational features being incorporated into the construction of the East Diversion Flood Control Project on the east side of Roseau. Some projects have been completed while other are still under construction or are planned for future construction. The elements at the north end of the project are complete and elements will continue to be added as the project construction moves south towards the City Park.

Due to the diversion channel originating in the Roseau City Park, it affords the opportunity to connect existing multipurpose trails in the city and City Park to be extended, uninterrupted the full length of the diversion project, or about 4+ miles from the City Park to a trail loop at the north end of the project. Additionally the diversion project will incorporate the construction of a river crossing with pedestrian trail from the City Park to the Roseau Oak Crest Golf Course, connecting this new diversion trail directly to both side of the city, via City Park and the existing city trail network.



Other amenities that will be incorporated into the diversion project include bird watching stations at the north end of the diversion near the Roseau River and Sanitary Lagoons, both excellent areas to view various species of birds. Motorized recreation has also been accommodated with a 5 mile ATV trail designation and 40 acre ATV/motocross challenge course.

The project will also involve the planting of over 1,000 sapling trees to create new wildlife sanctuary areas along the diversion corridor.
